#### Section 4. Laws and Permits

- A. Vendor must comply with all relevant local codes and regulations, and state and federal laws with regard to the use of the designated Space.
- B. Vendor is responsible for obtaining and paying for any and all business licenses, permits, and taxes that are required for its operation, including city, county and state sales taxes.

#### Section 5. Vendor Responsibilities; Vendor Conduct; Use of Space

- A. Vendor is responsible for all sales taxes on items sold and for reporting and paying sales taxes to the appropriate government agencies.
- B. Vendor is responsible for the security and safety of Vendor's equipment, monies, supplies, and related items.
- C. The Copernicus Foundation will not redeem any paper tickets for the sale of Vendor's merchandise.
- D. Vendor's use of the Space is non-transferable. Vendor may not allow anyone else to use the Space without the prior express permission of The Copernicus Foundation.
- E. Vendor is <u>prohibited</u> from taping, stapling, nailing, hanging or attaching, in any manner whatsoever, items to the tent and shall be held liable for any damage to the tent, frame or canopy.

#### Section 6. Indemnification and Release

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby irrevocably acknowledged, Vendor hereby agrees to release and hold The Copernicus Foundation, its officers, directors, employees, and agents harmless from any and all claims arising from any injuries, losses or damages, whether to person or property, caused by the negligence of Vendor, its employees and agents. Further, Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold The Copernicus Foundation harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, losses, costs, charges, expenses, damages and liabilities whatsoever including, but not limited to, the cost of reasonable attorney's fees which The Copernicus Foundation may be required to pay, sustain, suffer or incur by reason of or in connection with the operation of Vendor at the Taste of Polonia extending from set up, during all times of the Festival, through the complete teardown of Vendor's operation.

- B. The Copernicus Foundation reserves the right to impose additional rules and regulations as The Copernicus Foundation deems necessary.
